## IBC Annual Meeting

### Dr. Tom Hoenig, President Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City

Thomas M. Hoenig is president and chief executive officer of the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City and the senior member of the Federal Reserve System's Federal Open Market Committee, the key body with authority over national monetary policy in the United States. Dr. Hoenig directs Federal Reserve activities in the Tenth Federal Reserve District. The Bank is one of 12 regional banks in the Federal Reserve System. He joined the Federal Reserve Bank in 1973 as an economist and was a senior officer in banking supervision during the U.S. banking crisis of the 1980s. He assumed the role of president on October 1, 1991. He currently serves as chairman of the Federal Reserve Conference of Presidents – Committee on Regulation, Bank Supervision and Legislation. Dr. Hoenig has been especially outspoken about the regulation of the financial industry and the role of monetary policy during the recent crisis.

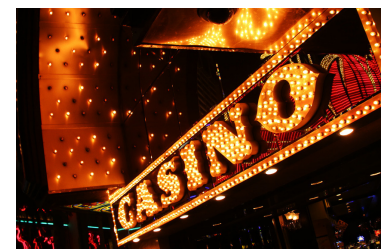

## Accommodations

## Directions

Vail Cascade Resort & Spa is located 100 miles west of Denver via Interstate 70 and 35 miles east of the Vail/Eagle County Airport via U.S. Highway 6 and Interstate 70. Colorado Springs is located 170 miles south of Vail and Grand Junction is 150 miles to the west along the Interstate 70 corridor. The resort provides complimentary shuttle service to both villages.

**FROM DENVER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT:** Take I-70 West to Exit 176 (main Vail). At end of the ramp enter the roundabout and go to the left under the Interstate. Enter the 2nd roundabout and turn right on South Frontage Road (towards Lionshead). The resort is 1.5 miles down on the left.

**FROM EAGLE AIRPORT:** Take I-70 East for 40 minutes. Exit 173 (West Vail). Enter the roundabout and follow signs to South Frontage Road/Vail Village/Lionshead. The resort is located 1 mile down on the right.

## What to Wear – Anything Goes!

Casual dress is recommended for comfort and fun during the convention. Friday evening there will be a dinner and entertainment. You may want to wear something comfortable enough to dance in.
