

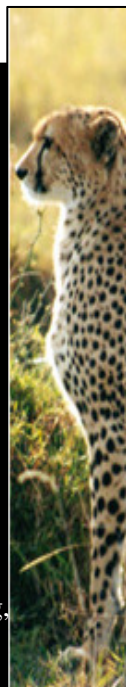

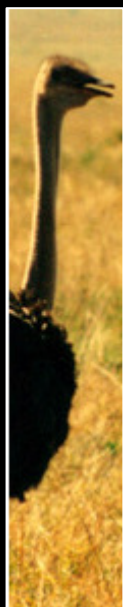

Elevated tees guarantee gravity-defying drives in the rarefied air, and at 6836 yards, beginners won’t be intimidated and experienced golfers will be well-challenged. The front nine meanders through the valley floor, crossing the scenic Eagle River several times. After this pleasant warm-up, you are ready for the thrilling back nine that winds up the mountain-side through aspen, lodgepole pine and fir – the only excusable distraction from your golf game comes from the stunning setting. The EagleVail Golf Club inhabits former verdant ranch and farm lands.

Accommodations

Lodging

A block of rooms, suites and condos have been reserved for IBCEF convention participants at the Vail Cascade Resort and Spa. To assure accommodation availability, reservations should be made no later than **Friday, August 26, 2011**. Directions

Vail Cascade Resort & Spa is located 100 miles west of Denver via Interstate 70 and 35 miles east of the Vail/Eagle County Airport via U.S. Highway 6 and Interstate 70. Colorado Springs is located 170 miles south of Vail and Grand Junction is 150 miles to the west along the Interstate 70 corridor. The resort provides complimentary shuttle service to both villages.

FROM DENVER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT: Take I-70 West to Exit 176 (main Vail). At end of the ramp enter the roundabout and go to the left under the Interstate. Enter the 2nd roundabout and turn right on South Frontage Road (towards Lionshead). The resort is 1.5 miles down on the left.

FROM EAGLE AIRPORT: Take I-70 East for 40 minutes. Exit 173 (West Vail). Enter the roundabout and follow signs to South Frontage Road/Vail Village/Lionshead. The resort is located 1 mile down on the right.

What to Wear - Anything Goes!

Casual dress is recommended for comfort and fun during the convention. Friday evening there will be a dinner and entertainment. You may want to wear something comfortable enough to dance in. Saturday evening a silent/live auction will be held and then roll the dice as casino night is back. Cocktail dress or black tie attire is optional.
