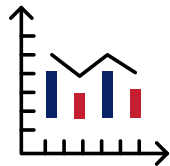

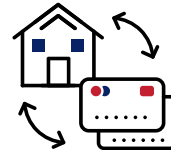
WAKE UP TO THE REAL STORY

Wake up and take action

Tax-exempt credit unions have an unfair advantage and are using it to take out their tax-paying community bank competition. Credit unions are earning millions and paying less in taxes than a family of four.
